SUBJECT: Proposal for a new Downtown Fairfield "Community Benefit District" -

Survey of Property Owners Please respond by Friday, September 19th,

2025

In the past several years, Downtown Fairfield has been undergoing exciting changes. With new businesses, a recently completed streetscape enhancement project, and more investment from the public and private sectors on the way, businesses and property owners are now asking what the future holds for this renewed, attractive, and growing Downtown Fairfield. To continue the positive momentum in Downtown Fairfield, the City has asked New City America, a California based company who specializes in business district development, to aid the Downtown Fairfield community to investigate whether property owners would be willing to consider supporting a new Downtown Fairfield Community Benefit District (CBD), which would fund special benefits for Downtown Fairfield stakeholders. Special benefits are those services that are in addition to what the City of Fairfield is currently providing to the District.

The positive momentum from the recent public and private investments into Downtown makes this the right moment for property owners to work with the City to plot a course for the area's continued growth and success. Key to that success is the creation of a sustainable funding mechanism to market and promote Downtown, clean and beautify Downtown sidewalks, respond to homeless issues, manage landscaping and parking, and maintain the recent public space upgrades to create an environment for continued steady growth. Downtown Fairfield is at a pivotal point and the Downtown community must ask itself, what will the District look, feel and be like in 5,10, or 15 years? We all feel it should be an attractive, beautiful, bustling, walkable and dynamic Downtown. With attractive development opportunities, and a growing business base of longtime and new restaurants, shops and services, Downtown Fairfield has the potential to evolve into a vibrant downtown neighborhood that serves property owners, businesses, and residents alike.

A new Downtown Fairfield CBD Steering Committee is being created to work with businesses, residents and Downtown property owners to investigate this process and determine a study area for a survey of property owners.



Through the enclosed initial survey, we are seeking feedback from Downtown property owners to gauge their level of conceptual support for this proposed Downtown Fairfield CBD.

Based on the results received from the returned surveys, we are hoping to better understand the type of special benefit services and improvements that interest the Downtown community. Any special benefit assessments paid through a property assessment district will solely fund improvements enhanced services that directly benefit assessed properties. The Downtown Fairfield CBD funds cannot, by law, be used outside of the new district boundaries nor can they replace existing City-funded services.

Please take time to complete the survey and submit it no later than Friday September 19th, 2025. The survey is short and easy and there are multiple ways to complete it.

The survey is a critical first step in exploring the feasibility of creating a Downtown Fairfield CBD. New City America will use the results to assess the feasibility forming the district, in partnership with the Downtown Fairfield CBD Steering Committee. If District formation is deemed feasible, the survey results will also guide the Downtown Fairfield CBD Steering Committee in determining a proposed service plan and proposed assessment costs to every benefitting parcel, to be voted on by Downtown Fairfield property owners in the Spring of 2026. It is important to remember: This is a property owner-driven process—meaning you and fellow owners will ultimately decide which services matter most and whether to fund them.

The Downtown Fairfield CBD Steering Committee will meet regularly throughout this process. *Note that the* Downtown Fairfield CBD *Steering Committee meetings are open to all business and property owners in Downtown Fairfield.* Please contact Jennifer Rice, City of Fairfield Economic Development Specialist by email at jrice@fairfield.ca.gov to receive the meeting invitations and details.
